They are hoping to receive a DOLA grant to refurbish the courthouse, have been working with the Sheriff on the jail expansion, and on efforts to combine the two dispatch centers. He reported on the current status of the Tabeguache Fire, and concluded by thanking the Vacancy Committee for their work to fill the vacant county commissioner position, and announced that Sue Hansen will be sworn in on July 18.

**Approval of Minutes:** The Chairman called for the approval of the June 12th minutes. A motion to approve was made by Allan Miller; seconded by Ray Langston and declared approved by voice vote.

**Treasurer's Report:** Deb Hunter reported on the current balance and checks paid. Addressing the website hosting expense required a vote of the Committee and a motion was made by Dianna Coram, seconded by Jim Dittmar and declared passed.
