Call to Order: Chairman Spencer Hamner at 6:36 p.m.

Invocation: Led by 2nd Vice Chairman Rick Fellabaum.

Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Dennis Mitchell.

Welcome of Elected Officials and Official's Report:

Clerk and Recorder Tressa Guynes: Reported details on the upcoming General Municipal Election April 3rd.

Treasurer Rosemary Murphy: Reported on the county taxes collected.

Assessor Brad Hughes: No report.

Coroner Dr. Tom Canfield: Reported on the Olathe homicide.

Welcome of Guests:

Candidates for Sheriff Gene Lillard and Justin Westbrook were recognized and each were given a few minutes to speak to the Committee.

Kay Heinschel was recognized to speak on behalf of Sue Hansen, candidate for county commissioner.

Minutes Approval: A motion was made by Ray Langston, seconded by Daniel Eddy and passed.

Treasurer's Report: Deb Hunter gave a report of the current balance, outstanding checks and alerted the Committee that there will be upcoming Assembly costs.

Unfinished/Ongoing Business:

Precinct Caucuses: Chairman Hamner reported on attendance numbers. 1st Vice Chairman Dave Laursen stated that 197 out of an allotted 200 delegates were designated to attend the county assembly on March 17th at the Montrose High School cafeteria.

New Business:

County Assembly: Rosemary Murphy, to be the Credentials Committee Chairman, explained how delegate check-in and vote counting would be handled. A \$20 fee payment is required at the time. Candidate nominations, time frame for speeches, Teller Committee procedures were reported on by Dave Laursen. Also occurring after lunch will be the designation of delegates to the State, CD3, SD6 and HD58 Assemblies as well as the election of District Captains.

Other Assemblies: 1st Vice Chair Laursen reported the SD6 and HD58 Assemblies will be held in Dolores on March 31st, and 33 delegates are eligible. CD3 will be held at the Denver Tech Hyatt on April 13th. The State Assembly will be at CU Boulder Event Center on April 14th, and the required fees for these assemblies was announced.

New District and Precinct Committee Captains: Chairman Hamner thanked the newly elected captains and asked that those new to the committee stand and introduce themselves.

Committee Chair/Affiliation Reports: No committee reports were given.

Closing Remarks/Announcements:

Kay Heinschel commented on the need to fill the still vacant positions on the Leadership Committee, and also spoke about judicial review of local judges.
