COLORADO SIXTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT REPUBLICAN ASSEMBLY

SATURDAY, MARCH 31, 2018 – 9:30 A.M.

Pursuant to Article XIII, Section D of the Bylaws of the Colorado Republican State Central Committee and Colorado Revised Statutes § 1-4-102 and § 1-4-601, notice is hereby given that the Colorado Sixth Senatorial District Republican Assembly shall be convened beginning at 9:30 A.M. on Saturday, March 31, 2018, at the Dolores Community Center, located at 400 Riverside Drive, Dolores, Colorado 81323. Check-in and credentialing for this Assembly will begin at 8:30 A.M.

The principal purposes of this Assembly of delegates shall be:

1. To designate Republican candidate(s) for the Sixth Senatorial District to the 2018 Primary Election ballot;
2. To select a Vacancy Committee; and
3. Any other business which may properly come before the assembly.

COUNTY DELEGATE APPORTIONMENT

A total of 103 delegates and 100 alternates have been authorized by the Sixth Senatorial District Executive Committee, which includes 3 at-large delegates (Executive Committee members). The remaining 100 delegates and 100 alternates have been apportioned to each county based upon votes for the Republican candidate for U.S. President cast in each county in the last general election and are identified below:
